As part of his visit to the QoG Institute and the Department of Political Science, Professor Ronald Inglehart from the University of Michigan, will give an open lecture entitled "Evolutionary Modernization and Social Change". Professor Inglehart is an internationally recognised political scientist who, for several decades, has been specialising in measuring public opinion. Among other things he has helped found the Euro-Barometer surveys and directs the World Values Survey. His research mainly deals with changing belief systems and their impact on social and political change. In his lecture in Gothenburg he will present the latest version of his thinking about the dynamics behind cultural change, and its impact on society.
